This Middlesex document is a certificate of assessment and an individual assessment for Ossulstone hundred for the third of three subsidies granted to James I in May 1624.

The certificate has been coated in gall. Only the month of March of the date of production (presumably, 1625), and a reference to the third subsidy, and a parliament that opened in 21 James I (1623-4) are legible. The commissioner Thomas Launderson wrote '1624' below his signature (rot 19).

The individual assessment has also been very badly damaged by water and gall. Several sections are illegible.

The manuscript headings 'servants of Mr James Demetrine' and 'the servants of Mr Peter Leonarte' (rot 3d) have not been indexed. Many topographical headings have unindexed sub-headings for aliens and assessors. Several places within St. Giles in the fields have separate index entries for lands and goods.
