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This list of inscriptions, town of Milford, was copied in 1934, under the auspices of the F.E.R.A. and the W.P.A. sponsored by the Connecticut State Library, was compiled under the supervision of Charles R. Hale, State Military Necrologist, assisted by Miss Mary H. Babin, Secretary.

From the Hale Collection of Connecticut cemetery headstone Inscriptions, Milford, LDS FHL microfilm rolls 3346 and 3347. This part (Part 1) includes the title page, the list of cemeteries, the map showing the locations of the cemeteries, and the list of inscriptions for "Founders Cemetery," which is actually not a cemetery, but instead the collection of memorial stones on the Milford Memorial Bridge, built to commemorate the founders of the occasion of Milford's 350th anniversary, in 1889.

Part 2 includes the list of inscriptions for "Milford Center Cemetery," including the "Old Section," plus a page from the index covering Terrills. The lists for St. Mary's Cemetery and the New Catholic Cemetery, and the bulk of the index, were not copied.
