THE TERRILL FAMILY OF CONNECTICUT

Note: The compiler is not a descendant of Roger Terrill, but members of his ancestral families intermarried considerably with the Terrills, and over the years he has collected a great deal of Terrill data. Work for several clients in past years has added to his knowledge of certain branches. Finally he was greatly aided by exchange of information with the late George Clarke Bryant, of Ansonia and if Mr. Bryant had been living he would have invited him to make this a joint article. Without such permission or endorsement, it would be unfair to make Mr. Bryant in any way responsible for the statements here made, and instead he acknowledges the indebtedness in this prefatory note.

English lines of descent have been claimed for Roger Terrill, but no evidence has been seen to sustain them. Five of Roger's sons left issue; we follow here only the three sons who remained in Connecticut, hoping at some future time to be able to follow down the Long Island and New Jersey branches.

Note: Few names are spelled in so many ways. Members of this family, since spelling has become standardized, have spelled it Ter-, Tur-, and Tyr-; -el, -ell, -il, and -ill; and even with one 'r' instead of two. No attempt has here been made to discriminate between the spellings preferred by different branches, and in the early generations there is no apparent uniformity.

It is realized that our account of certain branches is imperfect and far from complete, but it is felt, nevertheless, that it will be found very useful by those who are interested in this prolific family and that it may serve as a basis for a more complete genealogy when some historian of the family undertakes the task.

THE PARENTAGE OF SAMUEL MORSE OF DEDHAM, MASS.

Referring to Mr. Montgomery's article upon John Morse of Boston [*ante*, Vol. 24, p. 148] and his remarks upon my affiliation of Samuel Morse of Dedham with Samuel son of the Rev. Thomas Morse of Hinderclay, I should like to depart from my usual custom of letting the evidence speak for itself and analyze it a little.

I. Ages

According to the Shipping List, Samuel of Dedham was born in 1585 and his wife Elizabeth in 1587, Joseph in 1615 (evidently their son), and Elizabeth Daniel in 1633 (shown by Mrs. Holman, Register, 88:383, to have been undoubtedly their grandchild, the child of their daughter Elizabeth).

Samuel Morse, son of the Rev. Thomas, was baptized 12 June 1576, and his wife, Elizabeth Jasper, on 30 Jan. 1579/80.

John Morse, son of Samuel of Dedham, if he is, as seems to me quite likely, the man referred to in the Shipping List of the Speedwell of 30 May 1656, was born, according to that list, in 1616 [*Am. Gen.* 24:149].

John Morse, son of Samuel, the son of the Rev. Thomas, was baptized 28 Feb. 1607/8.

Anyone who has used the Shipping Lists is aware of the fact that the ages stated therein are often very inaccurate and at best are only approximate. The important thing was to show whether the person was of age or a minor, and whether the adults had complied with the law

and taken the oath of supremacy. Consequently, where the age given in the Shipping List coincides with that of the man with whom one seeks to identify him, it is corroboratory evidence that they are the same person, but where such is not the case it does not necessarily exclude such identity. This opinion is in accord with that of the late J. Gardner Bartlett, Esq., with whom I once discussed this very problem. In the present instance it may also be noted that the age of Joseph, as given in the Shipping List, approximates that of Joseph, son of Samuel, son of the Rev. Thomas.

Genealogists know that the ages given in depositions and on gravestones in New England during the 17th and 18th centuries are usually only approximate and are apt to vary more or less from the actual age. The writer once made a list of a number of depositions from the Essex County (Mass.) Court Files and in the majority of cases they varied from one to ten years from the true age. The last variation, I admit, is very rare. One must also remember that the Shipping Lists, as we now have them, are only copies of the original lists taken and allowance must be made for copyist mistakes.

The writer has found more serious errors in these lists, involving the domiciles of the persons listed. For example, Allan Perley and Francis Peabody are listed as coming from St. Albans, but research has shown that neither name occurs in St. Albans and that the Peabodys came from Leicestershire and the Perleys from Sussex. One is led to conclude that the parson at St. Albans made a business of granting certificates.

The result of all this is that the discrepancy in the ages of Samuel Morse of Dedham and his wife Elizabeth and, perhaps, in that of his son John, as compared with those of Samuel son of the Rev. Thomas, his wife Elizabeth and his son John, while some evidence against the identification, is by no means conclusive evidence. Moreover, it must be noted that the age of Joseph, son of Samuel of Dedham, practically agrees with that of Joseph, son of Samuel, son of the Rev. Thomas.

II. Families

Samuel Morse of Dedham and his wife Elizabeth had the following known children: 1. Elizabeth (cf. Mrs. Holman's article, *op. cit.*), who married about 1630 Robert Daniel, later of Watertown; 2. John, married about 1635-6 Annas; 3. Daniel, married about 1638 Lydia Fisher; 4. Joseph, born about 1614-15, married 1 Sept. 1638 Hannah Phillips; 5. Mary, married 10 Aug. 1641 Samuel Bullen. It is also possible that Thomas Morse, who was admitted to the Dedham Church in 1640, was another son, who died s. p. before his father.
