with in New England Yeoman for and in Consideration
of three pounds three shillings money already paid to me y^e
s^d Jeremiah Board before y^e Booking hereof have Given Grant
Bargained and Sold and by these presents do Give Grant
Bargain and Sell unto Dan^l Torrill of s^d Milford, in y^e County
and Colony aforesd a certain pcell of Upland within y^e bounds
of s^d Milford within y^e field called New Meadows plain in
Quantity seventy five Pole or Rods of land bounded with y^e
land of s^d Torrill Northwardly fifty Pole, with a Highway
Westward one Pole and an half, with Botsford land Eastward
one Pole and an half with y^e Boards land Southwardly fifty
Pole, All which pcell of land of seventy five Pole or Rod as a-
bounded with all the Appurtenances and Priviledges y^e unto
belonging or any wayes appertaining y^e s^d Dan^l Torrill his heirs
or Assigns shall Have, Hold, Occupy and Improve and quietly
Possess and Enjoy without any Lett or Molestation from me y^e
s^d Jeremiah Board or my heirs, Exors or Admrs forever. hereafter
And farther I y^e s^d Jeremiah Board for my self and my heirs do
Covenant to and with y^e s^d Torrill and his heirs That he y^e s^d
Torrill and his heirs shall be secured and Defended from all
legal Claims or Demands thatt any person or persons shall make
y^e unto or any part y^e of forever In Witness w^h of and for y^e full
Confirmation of y^e Premises, I y^e s^d Jeremiah Board have this
29th day of May, in y^e year of our Lord Christ 1715 and in y^e
5th year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign Lord George of great Brit-
tain King &c. have sett to my hand and Seal in presence
of these Witnesses.

wholesaler and for his Encouragement for a lively Good and part
of his Portion the several pcells of land and Meadows last of s^d

256 All lying within y^e bounds of y^e Milford which was formerly y^e land and meadow of John Clark late of y^e Milford deceased, namely one parcel of land on Beavon pond plain four acres be it more or less bounded Easterly with y^e Highway or Common and with y^e land of Sam^l Clark Jun^r Northwardly and with y^e land of Sam^l Clark Westwardly and with y^e land of John Botsford, Timothy Botsford and John Rogers Southwardly. One other parcel of land in y^e West field in quantity about two acres within a fence at a place usually called Barn Lot bounded with an Highway Eastwardly and Northwardly with y^e land of Sam^l Clark Sen^r Southwardly and with y^e land of Ser^g John Camp Westwardly. Also one parcel of land in y^e West field by y^e Sea side usually called y^e middle plot in quantity two acres and an half be it more or less bounded an Highway Northwardly and with y^e Sea Southwardly and with y^e land of M^r George Allin Eastwardly and Westwardly also And also one parcel of meadow in y^e West field at y^e meadow usually called in quantity about two acres be it more or less bounded by y^e Sea Southwardly and with y^e meadow of M^r George Allin Eastwardly and with y^e Canfield's land and Swamp land Northwardly Westwardly. Also a parcel of Swamp land about two acres joining to this y^e parcel of meadow as yet undivided from y^e Swamp of y^e Successors of y^e above John Clark deceased who was y^e natural brother of y^e above Ruth Wheeler this parcel of Swamp in y^e whole is undivided at six acres bounded with y^e Meadow formerly called Harmer Clark's Southwardly and with y^e Swamp mainly belonging to Botsford Eastwardly with y^e Successors be Timothy Baldwin etc Northwardly and y^e Swamp land of Nathan Baldwin and Canfield Westwardly. All which parcel of land & meadow above described with all appurtenances & Privileges y^e unto belonging on any wayes appertaining y^e Daniel Terrill Jun^r himself, his heirs and assigns shall have and hold possess and quietly enjoy as a good and indefeasible Estate of inheritance without any let or disturbance from his y^e Successors or Adam forever And further We y^e said Daniel Terrill and Ruth Wheeler above do Covenant and promise for our selves and our heirs to secure defend y^e said Daniel Terrill and his heirs from all legal claims and demands that shall be hereafter made to y^e said parcels of land and meadows by any person or persons whatsoever And for y^e full Confirmation of y^e Premises have sett to our hands and Seals this third day of June in y^e 30 year of our Sovereign George of great Britain King Defender of the Faith etc and in y^e 10 year of our Lord Christ 1765
