in a two lts purchase And two Rights in a single ltt purchase Not as yet
Layed out However hereafter they may be litted And bounded the S^r Samuell
Biscoe is to Have and to hold use Occupy posses & Enjoy with all the benefits
privileges and Appurtenances thereunto belonging to him y^e S^r Sam^l Biscoe
his Heirs and Assigns for ever And farther y^e S^r Richard Bryan do Covenant
And Engage to y^e S^r Sam^l Biscoe his heirs Executors Administrators & Assigns
shall Quietly & Peaceably posses and hold & Enjoy all and singular the aforesaid
purchases of Land & that free & clear & freely And Lawfully acquitted & discharged
from all manner of former And other Gifts, Grants bargains or Sales or any
Incumbrances Title or Claim whatsoever from any person or persons
whatsoever that shall Lay any Legall Claim thereunto or to any part thereof
