

NOW all Men by these Presents, That we *Dan^l Turrel*
 and *Asahel Turrel* both of *Stratford*
 are Holden, and stand firmly Bound and Obligated unto *Andrew Burr*
 Esq, Judge of the Court of Probate for the District of *Fairfield*
 in the Penal Sum of *One hundred pounds* lawfull money
 of said Colony: To be paid to the said *Judge*
 or to his certain Attorney, or Successors, in *his office* To the which
 Payment well and truly to be made and done, we the said *Dan^l and Asahel*
 do bind Ourselves, and each of us, our Heirs,
 Executors, and Administrators, and each and every of them, for, and in the whole,
 Firmly by these Presents, Signed with our Hands, and Sealed with our Seals. Dated
 at *Fairfield* the *20th* Day of *Dec^r* in the *34th*
 Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord *George 4th* by the Grace
 of G O P of Great-Britain, France and Ireland KING, Defender of the Faith, &c.
 Annoque Domini, One Thousand, Seven Hundred and Sixty

THE Condition of this Obligation is such, That if the above Bounden *Dan^l Turrel*
 of all and singular the Goods, Chattels, Credits and Estate of *Her^l Turrel*
 Deceased, do make, or cause to be made a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular
 the Goods, Chattels, Credits & Estate of the said Deceased, which have, or shall come to
 the Hands, Possession or Knowledge of the said *Dan^l*
 or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or Persons for him; and the same
 do make do Exhibit, or cause to be Exhibited into the Registry of the said Court of
 Probates in the District of *Fairfield* at or before the *first Tues^{day}* Day
 of *March* next ensuing: And the same Goods, Chattels Credits and Estate;
 and all other the Goods, Chattels, Credits & Estate of the said Deceased at the Time of his
 Death, which at any Time after shall come into the Hands or Possession of the said
Dan^l or into the Hands or Possession of any other Person or
 Persons for him, do well and truly Administer according to Law. And further, Do
 make or cause to be made a true and just Account of his said Administration, at or
 before the *first Tues^{day}* Day of *June* next And all the rest and residue of
 the said Goods, Chattels, Credits and Estate which shall be found remaining upon the said
 Administration Account; the same being first Examined and Allowed by the said
 Court of Probate, shall deliver and pay unto such Person or Persons respectively as the
 said Court of Probates, by their Decree or Sentence, pursuant to the true Intent and
 Meaning of the Law shall limit & appoint. And if it shall hereafter Appear that any
 last Will and Testament was made by the said Deceased; and the Executor or Exe-
 cutors therein Named do Exhibit the same into the said Court, making Request to have
 it Allowed and Approved accordingly; If the said *Dan^l Turrel*
 being thereunto required, do render
 and deliver the said Letters of Administration, (approbation of such Testament being
 first had and made) in the said Court, then this Obligation to be Void and of none
 Effect; or else to remain in full Force and Virtue.
