Know y^e That Jo^{seph} Torrill and Gamaliel Torrill both of Milford in
the County of New Haven in his Majesty's Colony of Connecticut in New
England Yeomen Doth for And in Consideration of a Certain parcelle
of Land lying within the Township of New Milford in y^e above sd^d Colony
of Connecticut being an Whole Share Right of Land or all y^e Land in sd^d
New Milford which by Right of purchase did belong to Dacon Sam Camp
of sd^d Milford now by Deed made over to his son Enos Camp & by y^e sd^d Enos
Camp in way of Exchange by a Deed under his hand & Seal to y^e sd^d Joseph
Torrill and Gamaliel Torrill made over now in Consideration of y^e above sd^d Whole
Share of Right of Land he y^e sd^d Joseph Torrill and Gamaliel Torrill have by
these presents in way of exchange given Granted Bargained sold aliened con-
veyed And Confirmed And by these presents do fully freely and absolutely by Ex-
change Give grant bargain sell aliene convey & Confirm unto him y^e sd^d
Enos Camp his heirs And assigns for ever all that parcelle of Land lying within
the Township of Milford above Which was those honoured Father John Torrill's
half Division lying above Whaler's farm containing seven Acres be it more or less
bounded with Fletcher Newton's Land Northwardly with y^e sd^d Enos Camp's Land
Westwardly with Enos Land both Eastwardly & Southwardly or his power otherwise
bounded or Reported to be bounded Together with all such Rights Liberties Privileges
Inclosures and Appurtenances as in Any kind appertains to y^e same To Have
and to hold all y^e sd^d Bargained promises and the Appurtenances thereof unto
the sd^d Enos Camp his heirs and assigns To his and there own only sole proper
Use benefit and Reliance for ever And y^e sd^d Joseph Torrill & Gamaliel Torrill
do for themselves their heirs Executors & Administrators Covenant Promise Grant
& Agree to And with y^e sd^d Enos Camp his heirs And assigns in manner &
for following viz: That at y^e time & sealing and delivery of these
Presents the sd^d Joseph Torrill & Gamaliel Torrill are the true sole & Lawfull
owners of y^e above bargained promises And do stand Lawfully seized thereof
in their own Right in Good Simple: Stare usq^{ue} in themselves good Rights
full Power & Lawfull Authority to exchange & dispose of y^e same in manner
as above And y^e sd^d Enos Camp his heirs and assigns shall And may Standfast
for ever peaceably possess y^e same free and Clear And further y^e sd^d Joseph Torrill
and Gamaliel Torrill do for themselves their heirs Executors & Administrators
for ever hereafter Covenant Promise Bind and Oblige themselves by
them to WARRANT secure and defend all y^e above granted promises
& y^e Appurtenances thereof unto y^e sd^d Enos Camp his heirs and assigns
for ever In witness whereof y^e sd^d Joseph Torrill & Gamaliel Torrill
have hereunto set their hands and Seals y^e seventeenth Day
of February Anno Domini 1718 or 20

All People to Whom these Presents shall come great-
-ing know ye that we Theophilus Baldwin of y^e Town of New Milford
in New Haven County and Joseph Dock & Abigail Dock wife to y^e Joseph
Dock of New Town in Fairfield County all within y^e County of Connecticut
in New England for and in consideration of a valuable consideration in
hand already received which is to our full satisfaction and contentment
have relinquished and for ever quitted claim unto and by these
Presents do fully freely and absolutely and firmly approve Ratify &
confirm all our right title claim interest whatsoever unto a certain tract
or parcel of Land (that was our honoured father Theophilus Baldwin
late of Milford deceased and since his death assigned and
& sold out to our honoured mother as part of her Dowry containing
seven Acres and a halfe situated & being within y^e bounds of Mil-
ford aforesaid on a place called y^e Low hill and is bounded Easterly
with Common land or high ways; Southwary with Land
belonging to Low Silvanus Baldwin & Nathaniel Farrand or a high way
and Northwary with Land sold out to our Brother Josiah Baldwin being
part of y^e same sold unto our brother in Law Enos Camp of y^e Town
of New Milford in y^e County of New Haven aforesaid. To him y^e said
Enos Camp and to his heirs and assigns for ever to have and to hold to
hold to him and his heirs and assigns for ever as a free absolute &
indefeasible estate of Inheritance to his and there. Our proper Use Benefit
and behoofs for ever, Hereby Warranting the said Enos Camp his heirs &
assigns in y^e quiet & peaceable Possession of the above Described Land
against all and every person & persons whatsoever that shall lay any legal
claim therunto or any part thereof from us or under us or any of us for
ever to defend. In Witness whereof we y^e said Theophilus Baldwin Joseph
& Abigail Dock have hereunto set our hands and Affixed our Seals this
Thirteenth day of November In the fifth year of y^e Reigne of our Sovereign
Lord George of great Britain France & Ireland
King Defender of y^e Faith. Anno Domini 1719 one Thousand seven
hundred & eighteen &c.
