DECLARATION OF A WIDOW FOR PENSION.

To be executed before Judge or Clerk of Court.

On this 11th day of May, A. D. eighteen hundred and ~~seventy~~ eighty
personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace, of the
....., a Court of Record in and for the County and State aforesaid, Lora
Turrel, aged eighty four years, a resident of
Mantua Township, County of Muskegon, State
of Iowa, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is
the widow of Philander Turrel, who served the full period of sixty
days in the (1) military service of the United States in the War of 1812, and who was the identical
Philander Turrel who (2) enlisted in Captain
Headley's Company, Ohio volunteers
Regiment, Brigade, Division, at
..... on the day of,
181 , and was honorably discharged at on the

day of, 181 ; that (3) she says that her husband
Philander Turrel received Bounty land warrant No
20788 for forty acres, act of 1850 issued Oct 1, 1851. That
he located the said warrant on the S 1/4 of S 8 1/4 Sec 27
T 72- R 16 West in Muskegon County, Iowa. She says
that by reason of infirmity of age and extreme
weakness she is unable to travel to Albia nine miles
to make this application before clerk of courts
that she was married under the name of Lora Beebe to said

Philander Turrel, on the 25th day of
December, A. D. 18 11, by she don't remember name, at
State of New York, there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that her
said husband died at Mantua Township, on the twenty fourth
day of March, A. D., 18 74 and that she has not remarried since his death; that

at no time during the late rebellion against the authority of the United States did she or her said husband adhere
to the cause of the enemies of the Government, giving them aid or comfort, or exercised the functions of any office
whatever under any authority, or pretended authority, in hostility to the United States; that she will support the
Constitution of the United States; that she is not in receipt of a pension under any previous act; that she makes
this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension rolls of the United States, under the provisions of the
act approved February 14, 1871, and hereby constitutes and appoints, with full power of substitution and revoca-

tion, Isiah L. Young of Albia Iowa
her true and lawful attorney, to prosecute her claim, and obtain the pension certificate that may be issued; that
her post office is at Albia, County of Muskegon
State of Iowa; that her domicile or place of abode is Mantua
Township.
