Stratford in the County of Suffolke being weakly of body but
of sound minde & memory thank be to god therfor taking in
minde the mortality of my body and considering that it is appointed
to forsake me once for ever do make and bequeath this my last will
and testament that it shal be in full Principally and first of all I
give and bequeath my soule into the hands of god that gave
it and my body I bequeath to be buried Burial nothing
doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same againe by the mighty power of God and as touching
my worldly estate I give devise and dispose of the same in the
following manner and forme

Item I give and bequeath to Ruth my beloved Wife my
just debts and Funerall Charges are paid all my household
goods and other moveable estate to be her eiers for ever
Further I give to my said wife one third part of my dwelling
house and one third part of all my Land and one third part of
my best mill & one third part of my Sawmill to be for her
use during her Natural Life

Item I give to my Eldest Son David Toril three acres of Land
at the southerly end of the Land I purchased of Theophilus
Nichols Esq^r

Item I give to my Daughter Ruth Sherman five shillings which
together with what she hath had already is the whole of
her Portion

Item I give to my Daughter Abigail Toril five shillings

Further my Will is that the Remains of my estate shall be divid
among my Children after the Names and in the following man
ner viz David Toril Daniel Toril Jonathan Toril Nathaniel
Toril Asa Toril & Josephiah Toril Comfort Eunice and Lewis
Toril my said Sons to Divide equally in said Remains of my
estate and my said Daughters Comfort Eunice and Lewis to Divide
equal in of same my said Daughters Comfort Eunice and Lewis

Each of them to have two thirds & more or less of my Sons
before named yet further my Will is that if my Estate shall
amount so that my Daughters Comfort Anne and Louis shall
have more then fifty one pound each then that my Daughter
Abigail Anne shall have an equal Share with them & what
is above fifty one pound above

Furthermore I do hereby Constitute make name & name my beloved Wife
Ruth and my Son David Twiss to be my Executors of this
my Last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly Revoke all
other Wills or Testaments by me made Ratifying and Confirming
this and no other to be my Last Will and Testament in Writing
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twentieth
Day of May Anno Domini 1746

At a Court of Probate held in Hartford August 6th Day 1754

Then Personally appeared Her: Odell & Israhel Burrill two of the
Witnesses to foregoing Will and made Oath that they saw Nathaniel Twiss
sign & seal the foregoing Will sign & seal the same & heard him declare it to
be his Last will & Testament & that they Judge him to be of sound Mind
& Memory & that they signed as Witnesses in presence of 2 Testators and
saw the other witnesses sign the same. all said Court personally appeared
Ruth & David Twiss named Executors to said Will & accepted of title & committed
to them by 2 Testators & they then exhibited the Will in order for Probation
& same being proved is by said Court approved & ordered to be recorded
