

Frederick Jarril hath for his Second division of meadow two acres and one rood but it more or less, lying in the Oyster meadow, bounded with the Creek East, with Mr. Howlers South with the Common West, and with John Rogers North,

Mr. Zachariah Whitmore hath for his half Division of Land two twenty acres, and one rood, whereof one parcel containing one acre and is equal it to other Land, five acres in all three acres but it more or less lying on the North meadow, plains, bounded with his own meadow West, with the Prisons South, with the Common East, and North, Another parcel containing Eighteen acres and one rood and is equal it to other Land thirty six acres and a half in all fifty four acres, and three roods but it more or less, lying on the North meadow plains, also bounded with a high way South, with the Prisons West, with the Common East, with a Swamp North, Another parcel on Adding plains containing three acres and is equal it to other Land four acres and one rood, in all four acres and one rood, but it more or less bounded with a high way East, and North, with the Jones West, with his own South, (Note: thirty eight acres and a half in the parcels in North meadow, plains and two acres and one rood in Adding plains is not to be charged with Rates.

Richard Platt hath for his half Division of Land Sixteen acres and one rood, and for Satisfaction for his home lot one rood and is equal it to other Land, four acres and twenty pole in all twenty acres a half and twenty pole, but it more or less, lying on bare hill, bounded with the Common North, East, and West, with John Stearns South, (Note) four acres and twenty pole for Satisfaction is not to be charged with Rates.

Richard Platt hath for his Second division of meadow two acres three roods and eight pole but it more or less, lying in the fresh meadow, bounded with a high way South, with Mr. Whitmons East, with the Common North, with Andrew Bontons West, now in the hands of Richard Shute.

Mr. Zachariah Whitmore hath for his Second Division of meadow four acres three roods and sixteen pole, but it more or less, lying in the fresh meadow, bounded with a high way South with Thomas Wicks East, with the Common North, with Richard Platts West.

John Lane hath for his half Division of Land Six acres and one rood whereof three acres and twenty pole, but it more or less, lying on a Swamp plains bounded with a high way South, with Thomas Wicks East, with the Common North, with John Baldwins West, Another parcel three acres, and twenty pole and is equal it to other Land, three acres and twenty pole, but it more or less, lying on a new meadow plains bounded with a high way East, with the Common South, (Note) Thomas Bakers South with John Baldwins North. (Note) two acres for Satisfaction is not to be charged with Rates.

John Lane hath for his Second Division of meadow one acre and two pole more or less, lying in the Oyster meadow, bounded with a Creek North, with Thomas Bakers East, with the Common South, with the Prisons West.
