

Thomas Sanford

Thomas Sanford hath for his half Division of Land sixteen Acres and one Rodd, whereof one Parcel lyeth on the Indian field the South Shott Containing three Acres one Rodd and ten pole, and to Equall it to other Lands one Rodd and twenty five pole, in all three Acres an half and thirty five pole, being bounded with Thomas Welch West, and a high way South (four Rod wide) John Brown North and the Common East. Note that one acre and an half and two pole of this is not to be charged with Rates.

Item one Parcel more Lying in the Captains Neck Containing three Acres and to Equall it with other Lands two Acres in all five Acres be it more or less, bounded with a high way North, East is west, Note the high way on the East side is eight Rod wide, and bounded with his own Land South. Note Thomas Welch and Thomas Whoolby are to have a passage for the Carting of hay through it. Note, that three Acres of this parcel is not to pay Rates.

Mary Plumb

Mary Plumb, widow hath for her half Division of Land twenty three Acres and an half whereof one parcel of it lyeth in the Valley beyond the North hill it to other Land, seven Acres three Rods and thirty pole in all twenty three Acres one Rodd and thirty pole, be it more or less, being bounded with the Swamp or Common near the Swamp South, the hill North, the Stoned East, and the Common or Swamp near Mr. Whitmans Land west. Note, there is a high way of four Rod wide goes through it. Note, that thirteen Acres and ten pole of this is not to pay Rates.

Roger Currit hath for his half Division of Land seventeen Acres and twenty pole, which lyeth on the New Meadows Plains or field the Middle Shott and to Equall it with other Land eight Acres one Rodd and twenty pole, in all twenty five Acres and an half be it more or less, being bound with Samuell Calby North, Nicholas Camp South, west Land west, and the high way East. Note, that seventeen Acres and three Rods is not to pay Rates.

Deacon George Clarke hath upon Receipt of his Divisions for his other Land one Parcel of Land lying by Mr. Bryants pasture Land Containing two Acres three Rods, and twenty five pole, and to Equall it to other Land two Acres and fifteen pole in all five Acres be it more or less, being bounded with the old Common line of Hones East, Torper Gunn South, the above Common line West. Note that two Acres three Rods and twenty one pole of this is not to pay Rates - - -

John Brown hath for his half Division of Land fourteen Acres and an half, whereof one parcel of Land lyeth in the Old Indian field the South Shott, Containing three Acres and an half and to Equall it with other Land half an Acre and fifteen pole, in all four Acres and fifteen pole, be it more or less, being bounded with Thomas Sanford South, Common East, North, the Common West, a pole of Land left for a passage against Davis Pond East. Note, a high way is to goe through it. Note, that three Acres and twenty eight pole is not to be charged with Rates.

Item one Parcel of Land Containing seven Acres three Rods and twenty pole, and to Equall it with other Land, three Acres three Rods and twenty pole.

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
