William Bodols hath for his first half Division Seven acres and one half and to Equall it to other Land, one acre and one half, and in all nine acres, but it more or less lying in the ferry lane, bounded with Jonathan Baldwins Land South, a path or highway west with Gilbert Baldwins Lot North, the Common East, one hundred and Sixty rods long, and nine rods in breadth.

Roger Berrill hath for his first half Division Seven acres and to Equall it to other Land five acres in all fifteen acres, lying all Wiggam hill, being bounded with the high way East and North, with a high way and the Ministers Lot, the Common or a little waste Land West, and a high way, and former Clarks South, and by that high way Nineteen rods in breadth and in length one hundred and Sixty rods, and by John Wills fence, the length of Wills Lot, and by the high way South, it is twelve rods wide.

Item, for his Last half Division Seven acres whereof one parcel lyeth beyond the Negroes wall containing Seven acres, and to Equall it to other Land, Seven acres in all fourteen acres, being bounded with his own Land and the Northrupps Land East, with Capt. Benders Land South, a path of six rods wide to the point West, Thomas Tibbals Land North.
