

Thomas Baker bought of Thomas Baker, all and every part and
property of his house homelott Upland and Meadow, lying in
Mifflord or Appurtenances therunto belonging or appertaining to the

Jonathan Mase hath given him by the town for a home Lott one
parcel of Land Containing three acres and an half be it more or less,
bounded with a Creek South, with a high way East, with a high
way North, with James Rogers West.

William Tomkins bought of Edward Reggs one parcel of Meadow Contain
three Rods be it more or less, lying in the New Meadow, bounded with a Creek

one acre and a half be it more or less, lying on four pond plains bound
with Roger Torril west, with George Clark Jun North, with John Rogers
East, and with his own Land South.

Roger Torril bought of Henry Botchford one parcel of Land
Containing one acre and a half, and of John Rogers one acre a half
be it more or less, lying together on four pond plains, bounded with a
west, with George Clark Jun, North, then Henry Botchfords East, and with
his own Land South.

Thomas Wheeler bought of John Swann his home Lott Containing
three acres, be it more or less, bounded with a high way west, with
James Prime South, with Thomas Wolches East, and Henry Lyons
North, and also one parcel more of Land Containing five acres and
a half, and twelve pole be it more or less, lying on bare hill bounded
with the high way East, Richard Platts North, with the Common west
and Henry Lyons South, also one parcel of Meadow, Containing four
