

George Hubbard hath one acre and a half be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with George Parks East, and with Thomas Effectors South.

Thomas Effectors hath one acre and a half be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with George Hubbard North, with a Creek East, and with John Birdfys on the South. (note) this is not to be charged with Rates.

John Lane hath one acre and a half be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with John Birdfys North, with a Creek East, and with Andrew Bentons South. (note) this is not to be charged with Rates.

Nicholas Camp hath six acres be it more or less, being bounded with a Creek East, and South, and with John Birdfys on the North.

Martha Beard widow hath nineteen acres be it more or less, being bounded with a Creek East, West, with Phillip Hattley North, with the Common East, and with George Parker Junr on the South.

Roger Terrill hath one acre be it more or less, being bounded with a Creek East and west, with John Birdfys South, and with Phillip Hattley North.

Joseph Baldwin hath two acres be it more or less, being bounded with a River West, with John Fowler North, with a Creek East, and with Thomas Piddals South.

John Fowler hath one acre a half and sixteen pole be it more or less, being bounded with the River west, with John Burwell North, with a Creek East, and with Joseph Baldwins South.

Nicholas Camp hath six acres be it more or less, being bounded with a Creek East, and South, with Joseph Baldwins and the Common West, and with Roger Terrill on the North.

Roger Terrill hath five acres be it more or less, being bounded with a high way Sargent Camps and Phillip Hattley South, with a Creek East, with a high way and the Common North, and with the Common West.

Phillip Hattley hath three acres be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with Roger Terrill North, with a high way East, and with John Rogers on the South.

John Rogers hath one acre and a half be it more or less, being bounded with a high way East, with John Smiths South, with the Common West, and with a Creek North.

John Smith hath two acres one rood and eight pole be it more or less, being bounded with a high way East, with John Rogers North, with Henry Botchford and John Burwell South, and with the Common West.

Henry Botchford hath one acre a half and sixteen pole be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with a Creek South, with John Smiths East, and with the Common North.

John Burwell hath three acres one rood and eight pole be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, with a Creek and John Smiths North, with John Fowler Upland East, and with his own Upland South.

George Clark Junr hath four acres and one rood be it more or less, being bounded with the River West, and South, and with the Common East and North.

Edward Riggs hath two acres be it more or less, being bounded with a Creek East, and South, and with the Common West and North.

Joseph Baldwin hath two acres a half and sixteen pole be it more or less, being bounded with Nicholas Camps East, and with the Common North, West and South.

Mr William Fowler hath for his mill Lot, one Island of meadow in the Common and South, be it more or less, bounded with the River, East, west, North.

George Clark Junr bought of Late Robert Purser, one Parcel of meadow lying on the East side, containing five acres, and one rood be it more or less, being bounded with the Common North, and South, Robert Purser North, and Henry Botchford East.

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
