 of Land in the Indian side against his owne meadow if it
 be thair to be had if not then he is to have but halfe
 of it thair

Item Miles Marwin hath liberty to have the remainder
 of his land that the towne gave him next to John Brown
 Land on this side of it in the Indian side

Item Samuel Colby hath part of his division granted in
 the same place in the Indian side next to the Indian line

Richard Spitt doth consent to have as much land at the pond
 as the place will comfortably afford

Item Richard Holbrook hath six acres of land given him by
 the town in this division alsoe the said Richard Holbrook
 hath liberty to have the use of one rood in the mill note
 for three years

Item Nicholas Camp hath liberty to have a partell of Land
 against his owne meadow in the fenny note as part of his
 division

Robert Donnes Richard Shute Joseph Waters Thomas Bots
 Agreed to cast lots for a piece of Land on the Indian side and
 they agreed to begin at the rock to lay it out and having
 cast lots Robert Donnes is to have the first lot Richard

Shute the second lot Joseph Waters the third lot and Thomas
 Bots the fourth lot

Item Henry Botsford John Board Thomas Ford John Smith
 And Thomas Carr these five men have liberty to have
 a halfe their division of Land in that note against their
 owne meadow and having agreed to cast lots and
 having cast lots they agreed to lay out that
