sollutly grant allien and sell and conferm unto the aboue saide Thomas
Jeners to him his haies eckseckators adminestrators and asaigns to
haue and to hould forever all the saide trackt or share of medow with
all the fence that doe now belong to the same without any lett mollest-
ation or incumberens what soever As alsoe I the saide Thomas Thorp
doe warant this my saele to stand good and ferm in law from any
parson or parsons what soever claiming any Right title or interest from
by or under me or of any of my procurement but that the aboue saide
medow shall be for the proper use and behoofe of the aboue saide
Thomas Jeners or any that shall goe partners with him in the aboue
saide saele to him them and thaire haies for ever and to the true and
