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clayming any Right or title from by or under me and to the true and through confermation of all the aboue said premisses I doe here unto sett my hand and fix to my seale this 30 day of november 1683

Artickles of agrement made and concluded upon the ferst day of december in the yeare of our lord god 1683 betwene Samuell Turell of the one party and Robart gouldsbury the other party aboute a exchang of lands as followeth

That the aboue saide Robart gouldsbury doth giue grant bargin and sell and exchand his upland and medow that he had at ackembameck on the south siede of the Islands within the bounds of brookhaven that is to say that which was Thomas Thorps nomb 42 as alsoe that which was Thoma smith nomb 43 and that which was Sakery hawkens nomb 44 these aboue said lotts both upland and medows that belong unto the severall lotts with y^e preveledges Imunitis apurtenanses that doe or shall belong unto the aboue saide upland and medowes the aboue saide Robart gouldsbury doth for himself his haies and asaigns doth sell allien and exchang and make over to the aboue saide samull Turell his haies and asaigns to haue and to hould for ever with out any lett mollestation or incomberence

whatsoever as alsoe the aboue saide Robart gouldsbery his haire and
asaings will warant this his saele and exchang to stand good and ferm
in law from any parson or parsons claiing any Right or title to
any parts of the aboue saide land or medows as alsoe all the housing
and fencing as it now standeth upon the said land

And in concideration of the aboue saide housing and lands the aboue
said Samuell Turell doth sell allien and make over and exchang unto
Robart gouldsbery his house that now he dwelse in and his shop with
the 5 akers of land it standeth upon as it was layd out mor or les
with the fencing and treese upon it with fife akers in the ould feeld
more or lesse as I had it of Joseph daves with the halue acomedaytions
the towne gaue me to be layd out akording as is exprest in Records
in the towns gift being fife akers in the little neck alRedy layd out
I say that I samuell Turell doth for my self my haire and asaigs
doth giue sell allien and make over the aboue saide housing and
lands and medow that is exprest in my gift unto Robart gouldsbery his
haire and asaings to haue and to hould for ever with out any lett or
mollestation or incomberence whatsoever as alsoe I the saide samuell
Turell my haire and asaings doe warant this my saele to stand good
and ferm in law from any parson or parsons whatsoever

know all men by these pressents that I Even oven in brookhaven in
the est Rieding of yourksheere alles in the county of suffolk doth
ingaege to pay or cause to be paid unto the widow katteren fancy
the full and Just some of twelf pounds of good curant pay march-
entable and as marchants take it that is to say aight pound

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to be paide the ferst day of aperell next ensueing the date hereof and
the other fower pounds the ferst of aperell next ensueing after com
twelf month I say that I even oven doth for myself my hairs and
asaings doe full ingaege to pay the aboue saide twelf pounds akording
to time and spesia unto the aboue saide widow fancy her haire and
asaings as alsoe I the saide even oven doe biende over that house
and land I had of Robart gouldsbery untell the aboue saide mones
be paide and to the true performence of the same I doe here unto
sett my hand this 30 day of novemb 1683
