Know all men by these presents that John Jeners dwelling in the towne of brookhaven in the est Rieding of yourksheere alles in the county of suffolk doth for valluable conciderations and a sum of mones allRedy paide to full sattisfacktion haue given grantt bargened and sould and doth by these presents giue grant bargin and sell unto samuell Turell of the aboue saide county Rieding and sheere all my Right title and Interest of a fiteene akers of upland as it was layde out more or lesse with the medows belonging to the same I say that I John Jeners doth for myself my haire eckseckators Adminestrators and asaigns doth absollutly sell allien and make over the aboue saide fiteene akers of land lying and beeing at the south at ackambameck number 45 unto the aboue saide samull turell his haire eckseckators Adminestrators and asaigns to haue and to hould for ever will Imunities and apurtenances that doth belong to the aboue saide upland and medows or shall belong unto it and further I the saide John Jeners my haire and asaigns doth warant this my saele to stand good and ferm in law from any parson or parsons whatsoe ever claying any Right title or Interest from by or under me but that the aboue saide lands and medowes shall be for the proper use and behoofe of the aboue saide samuell Turell his haire and asaig(ns) without any lett disturbance or incomberence whatsoever and to the true and through confermation of all the aboue saide premisses I doe hereunto sett my hand and sett to my seale this 1th day of desemb 1683 saigned sealed and delivered in the pressens of us John Jeners with a seale

This Indenture mad the [the] fiftenth day of may ana domi 1683 and in the therthth fift yeare of the Raigne of our soverng lord Charls the second: &c: betweene John wood of brookhaven in the est Rieding of new yourk of the one parte and Adam smith of smithfeeld* in the saide Rieding of the other party wittneseth that the said John wood for and in concideration of a valluable some allRedy Reseued and full sattisfacktion made the Resaite wher of is acknowlledged by these presents doe giue grant bargin allien and sell unto the aboue saide Adam and his haire for ever a serten devission of land at the south siede in sebameck† neck aJoyning to Richerd floyd on the est siede and to
