where as there was a voete the last towne meeting legally warned that there shuld be a petition sent unto his honer the governer that the latte ackt aboute swiene made by the assembly men shuld be suspended and not putt in execution untell the asembly meeteth againe in maij next whereupon on the day and date aboue written the towne by voete chose m^r Andrew gibb to wriet the saide petition in the behalf of the towne and to prefer the saide petition to the governer and to speak to it

Johnathan Roesse haue exchanged two lotts of upland and medow belonging to it the share that was sakery hawkens and the share [and the share] that was Thomas Thorps unto Robart gouldsbery his hairens and asaigns for ever with all preveledges belonging to it and Robart gouldsbery haue delivered in exchang the share that was John coombs and the share that was Richard floyds both upland and medowes unto Johnathan Roesse his hairens and asaigns to haue and to hould for ever with all preveledges belong to the same all the land liing at ackambamack the south sieide of the Island

william Jane haue exchanged his share of medow liing by the sieide of mount missery by the coming in of the harbor with m^r Joseph lee with all preveledges and apurtenanses belonging to it to haue and to hould for ever for and in concideration of three akers of land in nue towne that he had of william williams with all the preveledges and apurtenansses belonging to it to haue and to hould for ever this exchang is to them and there hairens and asaigns for ever
