This Indenture made at brookhaven in the county of suffolk upon long Island in the provence of new yourk the niententh day of desember in therty fift yeare of the Raigne of our soverenge lord Charls the second by the grace of god of great britten france and Irland defender of the faith, & : and in the yeare of our lord god one thousand six hundred aighty and three betweene Robart goulsbery and hanah his wife of brookhaven aforesaide yeaman of the one partty and samuell Turell of the same place black smith of the other partty wittnesseth: That for and in concideration of a dwelling house and cartan other lotts of land lying and being with in the township of brookhaven aforesaide to the saide Robart and hanah goulsbery in hand delivered by the saide samuell Turell before the ensealling of these pressents the saide Robart and hanah goulsbery hereby ecknowledging the Resaite there of and themselues to be there with fully sattisfied and contentted and doe there of and every part and parsell there of frely and clearely aqiit & discharg the saide samuell Turell his hairese exseckators Administrators or asaigns for ever by these pressents haue given grantted bargened and sould and doe by these pressents doe fully clearely and absollutly giue grant bargin allien asaigne and sett over unto the saide samuell Turell all my massauge and dwelling house together with all my lands and medowes lying and situatted upon ackembameck neck at the south siede of long Island within the township of brookhaven aforsaid being bounded esterly by Johnathan Roesse his land southerly by the sound or bay westerly by the land and medow formerly belonging to John Jeners and in the ockapation of the said samuell Turell and northerly by the comans being in all three lots and numbred forty two forty three forty fower and containeing fifty fieve akers of upland and medow more or les together with all and singular masuages tenements sellers lights casments gardens orchards fences pastures

inclossurs timbers trese herbege and all other preveledges benefitts and aparetenanses whatsoever to the saide house and lotts of land and medow belonging or in any way es apertaineing To haue and to hould the afore saide house lotts of land and medow and all other the saide bargened premisses unto the saide samuell Turell his hayres eckseckators Adminestrators and asaigns to his and there owne soele and proper use and usses for ever and we the saide Robart and hanah gouldsbury doe hereby covenant and promes that at the time of the enselling here of we ar the true soele and lawfull owners of the sayd house lotts of lands and medowes and all other the aboue granted premisses and haue in our selues full power good Right and lawfull athoraty to sell and dispoese the same

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And that all and every part there of is fre and cleare and clerly acquitted exonartted and discharged from all other and former gifts grants bargens saeles Joyntures dowres morgages titls trobels charges incomberences whatsoever had made comited or suffered by us the saide Robart and hanah gouldsbury at any time or times before the ensealling here of And that we the saide Robart and hanah gouldsbury our hairens exseckators Adminestrs doth asaignt the said lotts of land and medow and all other the aboue granted premisses unto the saide samuell Turell his hairens exseckators Adminestrators and asaigns against all poeple shall and will warant and defend alsoe to seale and deliver any other or former deede or covayence as the saide samuell Turell his hairens or asaigns shall be adviessed to by his counsell lerned in the law in wittnes where of the parttes to [to] these pressents haue here unto sett there hands and seales the day and yeare ferst aboue written sained sealed and delivered Robert gouldsbury hanah gouldsbury with seales in the pressens of

Know all men by these pressents that I Andrew miller of brookhaven doth for my selfe my hairens and asaigns haue given granted bargened and sould and exchanged my fifty aker lott lying in mount miserry number 15 unto John Tomson belonging to the aboue saide towne his hairens and asaigns for and in concideration the aboue saide John Tomson doth giue grant bargin and sell and exchang 16 akers of land lying westward of the swamp at the ould mans over against Andrew millers lott unto andrewew miller both. these haue exchanged the
