fathers william fances I say that Robart and hanah goul(s)bery doth
for themselues ther haies and asaigns doth absollutly sell allien and
make over the aboue saide half comeneg unto the aboue saide samuell
Turell to him his hairens and asaignes to haue and to hould for ever with
all timber trese Imunitis apurtenances preveledges that doe or shall
belong to the aboue saide half comeneg without any lett or disturbance
or mollestation whatsoever and further he warants this his saele to
stand good and ferm in law from any parson or parsons claiming any
Right tittle or interest from by or under me and farther the saide
goulbery shall giue a ferm bill of saele if Rquired for the aboue said
half comeneg
