Junior and hanah the wife now of daved genens doth for ourselves our haies exseckators adminestrator and asaigns doth absollute giue grant bargin sell allinat and make over to the aboue saide daved genens to him his haies exseckators adminestrators and asaigns to haue and to hould for ever with all timber(s) trese orchards yards back-sieds gardens or whatsoever preveledges Imunitis or inlargements doe belong to the aboue saide houssing and home lott with out any lett hinderence or incombence: and further we the aboue saide petter whietheare John Tooker and hanah genens doe warant this our saele to stand good and ferm in law from any parson or parsons whatsoever claiming any Right title or interest from by or under us or any one of us and further we shall if Required giue a more ferm deede or bill of saele for the aboue saide houssing and home lott and to the true and through confermation of all the aboue saide premisses we doe here unto sett our hands and fix to our seales this twenty second day of desember 1684
