Joseph daves haue sould unto Samull Turell now of est hampton two parsells of land in the ould feeld the one lying betweene Thomas bigs Junior and y^t which was John williams of the northwest end and hy way of Robart smiths lott and the other the back siede of the feeld the one siede Joynes to the widow muncy and the swamp upon the other siede butting upon petter whieteheare the two peses of land containeing fve akers or there abouets this aboue written land the aboue said Joseph daves haue bargened and sould for valluable cosiderations him moueing unto samuell turell and his haires forever to haue and to hould And in consideration the aboue sayde samuell turell doth ingaege to pay unto the aboue saide Joseph daves or his order or asaignes the full and Just some of feestene pounds that is to say forty shillens in mony pay for which he his to pay forty pounds of sheeps woole marchentable at the spring where he cometh and therteene pounds in marchentable oyle and whale bone that is to say two barells of oyle to m^r person* of Southampton and niene pounds in marchentable oyle and whaelebone to be paide to m^r John Thrope to be paide at or before the 15 day of aperell next ensueing the daete here of

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Thomas geners haue sould unto Abram daiton his fifteene aker lott at the poynt of gorges neck from him and his haires to the sayde daiton and his haires to haue and to hould for ever And in concideration the aboue sayd Abram daiton doth giue for echang two oxen that he had of Robart goulisbury and fve akers of land that is to be layd out to him that he wants of his alottmen(t) and saide Thomas genners takes the oxen Reseued the ferst time they are seene aliue and Tho geners pays for the Record

4 day of november 1680

Joseph Longbothem haue sould unto Andrew miller a three aker lott more or less in the ould feeld the uper end of the ould feeld lying betweene the widow geners and that which was goodman perings now Joseph longbothems I say that I Joseph longbothem haue for himselfe his haires and asaigns haue bargened and sould unto the aboue saide Andrew miller his haires and asaigns to haue and to hould for ever that *(This above entry is crossed out.)*
