Page 17½ Know all men to whom these presents shall come that I David Gardiner of ye Isle of wight in New Yorke Collony in America as agent unto Thomas Symons of Albermarle County or worth Carrolina greeting : know yee that for divers good Causes me therunto moveing : but more especialie for & in Consideration of ye sum of fourteene pounds of Currant mony of Boston : to bee to him in hand paid, by Jeremiah Conckling junior of East-hampton on Long Island in ye County of Suffolk in ye same goverment before ye Insealinge of these Presents : the rits thereof & every part thereof : the said Gardiner as agent fforesaid doth Acknowledge and of the same & every part thereof doe full acquitt & discharge ye said Conckling : have given granted bargained & sold : and doe hereby fully truly & absolutely give grant bargain & sell unto ye said Jeremiah Conckling all yt parcell of land lieing to ye Southward of the high way yt leadech toward ye norwest harbor of ye towne next unto ye land that is now in pe tenure & occupation of John Cirle Southward : & on ye west side one land belonging to Steven Stretton being two six aker lots as they are recorded in towne booke one unto Robert daiton & ye other unto Joseph hand of ye said Thomas Simons his father william Simons bought ye said two six aker lott bee they more or less to have & to hold ye
