In regard of ye want of a smith in this Towne yt is a workman: & John Pinny Tendering himself uppon some Conditions if hee may have some land for his settlment he will work of his trade for ye supplie of ye Towne what hee can & This Towne uppon that Consideration for his Incouragement have given & granted into him libertie to set himself upp a shopp & a dwelling house by ye othersmiths shopp & to have yt litle piece of land yt the ould pound formerly did stand on as far as to the scoole house for his use & Improvement only if ye said John Pinny should see cause hereafter to remove from this Towne hee is not sell away ye land from ye Towne but ye Towne is to give for his house & shopp reasonable satisfaction as hee & they can agree & also they have given & graunted unto him ye aforesaid John Pinny a sar-
