BOOK 4, page 9.—This is to Certifie all the inhabitants of this towne that the Counstable & oberseers takeing Notis of of the great disorder that is at the Meeting house upon the Saboth day to the great dishonour of gd & Reproach to Religion by Many persons staying abroad in time of publick worship and spending ther time in sleaping or talkeing Not being able to profit by ye word preacht: Notwithstanding the care that is taken to probide Roome in the house : doe therefore signifie that if such prsons who have been guilty bee not upon this Warning Reclaym we Resolve to take a list of ther Names and prsent them to the next sessions for sabath breakers as the Law Requires us : also we doe desire all Masters of ffamilys to take prticular Case of ther owne Children & serbts that so thare May Not bee that disorder which Now is by boys & Girls playing & Runing out & in in time of publike worship.
