Ashtwood hath two Acres and a half be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East and North, with the Common to the west and Richard Baldwin to the South.

Richard Baldwin hath two Acres be it more or less bounded with a high way to the East Cap. Ashtwood to the north the Common to the west and John Prudden to the South.

Benjamin Bonn hath two Acres one Rod and thirteen pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, Richard Baldwin to the North the Common to the west and Samuel Cloy to the South.

Samuel Cloy hath two Acres one Rod and twenty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, Benjamin Bonn to the North the Common to the west, and John Bracocks to the South.

John Bracocks hath one Acre and three Rods be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, Samuel Cloy to the North the Common to the west, and a high way to the South.

Henry Stonell hath two Acres and half and twenty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, and North, with the Common to the North and Nathaniel Baldwin to the South.

Nathaniel Baldwin hath two Acres be it more or less being bounded with the high way to the East, Henry Stonell to the North the Common to the west, and James Prudden to the South.

James Prudden hath two Acres be it more or less being bounded with the high way to the East, Nathaniel Baldwin to the North the Common to the west and Thomas Vffiler to the South.

Thomas Vffiler hath four Acres be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, James Prudden to the North the Common to the west and South.

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Thomas Baker hath three Acres and a half be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, and North, other Lots on the west and the Common on the South.

Stephen Trueman house lot of 2 Acres was afterward laid out between Thomas Baker & John Fletcher. John Fletcher hath two Acres three Rods and thirty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way on the East, the Common on the North other Lots on the west, and John Baldwin on the South.

John Baldwin hath two Acres one Rod and twenty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, John Fletcher to the North other Lots on the west and Francis Bolt on the South.

Francis Bolt or now Philip Bolt widow Sarah Bolt and Susa Bolt hath two Acres one Rod and twenty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, John Baldwin to the North other Lots on the west, and Micah Tomkins to the South.

Micah Tomkins hath two Acres one Rod and twenty pole be it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, Francis Bolt to the North other Lots on the west, and John Baldwin to the South.
