Samuel Coley

Samuel Coley hath three acres to it more or less being bounded with a high way to the East, with George Hubbard on the North, a pond George Clarke Sen. to the west, and with John Peacock on the South.

John Peacock

John Peacock hath two acres and three Rods to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the East and South, with George Clarke Sen. on the west, and with Samuel Coley and a pond to the north.

Joseph Northrupp

Joseph Northrupp hath given him by the town one home lot containing two acres bounded with a high way South the Common west, the Swamp north, and the Tibbatts Lot East.

Simon Loddell

Simon Loddell hath given him by the town of Millford for a house lot one half acre of Land laid out in the place appointed by the town measured by Eng. Francis being bounded with Silvanus Baldwins Land East the Common north and west and comes to a point South, so it lies on a triangle.

Further the said Simon Loddell hath a further Grant of addition to his home lot of one Rodd bounded with his former home lot Southward, and a high way west, and Walter Smith North, and Silvanus Baldwin East, laid out by Eng. Silvanus Baldwin and Eng. Samuel Burwell, and Eng. Thomas Clarke.

Walter Smith

Walter Smith hath given him by the town a home lot by the above said Loddell containing three Rods to it more or less, bounded with Simon Loddell South, a high way west, the Common north, and Silvanus Baldwin East, laid out by Eng. Silvanus Baldwin, Eng. Samuel Burwell, and Eng. Thomas Clarke, dated from Daniel Buckingham Esq.

Henry Stonell 14

Henry Stonell hath eight acres and three Rods to it more or less being bounded with a high way to the north, and East with John Baldwins on the South, and with Nathaniel Baldwins to the west.

Nathaniel Baldwin

Nathaniel Baldwin hath two acres and three Rods to it more or less being bounded with a high way to the north, with Henry Stonell to the East, with John Baldwins on the South, and with James Prudden to the west.

James Prudden

James Prudden hath three acres to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the North, with Nathaniel Baldwins on the East, with John Baldwins to the South, and with Thomas Vffits on the west.

Thomas Vffitt

Thomas Vffitt hath four acres to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the North, with James Prudden on the East with the meadow and John Baldwins on the South, and with George Hubbard and George Clarke to the west.

George Clarke Sen.

George Clarke Sen. hath three acres to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the North, and west with George Hubbard on the South, and with Thomas Vffitt to the East.

George Hubbard

George Hubbard hath three acres to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the west, with George Clarke Sen. on the North, with Thomas Vffitt on the East, and with the meadow to the South.

John Fletcher

John Fletcher hath Eight acres and a half to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the North, East, and South, and with John Lane on the west.

John Lane

John Lane hath four acres and a half to it more or less, being bounded with a high way to the North, and South, with John Fletcher on the East, and with George Hubbard to the west.
