Timothy Baldwin hath four acres and one Rod to it more or less, being bounded with the fence North, with John Baldwins East, with a high way South, and with the Common West.

Edmond Hainey Seven acres and a half to it more or less, being bounded with the fence North, with John Baldwins East, with a high way South, and with the Common West.

Edward Riggs hath five acres and a half to it more or less, being bounded with the fence North, with Andrew Dentons East, with a high way South, and with the Common West.

George Clark Junr hath two and forty Acres and bought of Timothy Baldwins half an acre of meadow in all two and forty acres, and a half to it more or less, being bounded with the Sea South, with his own meadow East, with the Common West, and with John Burwells West. (note) Six and twenty Acres of this is not to be charged with Rates.
