

Henry Botchford hath for his halfe Division of Land
 for his home lott, one Road whereof one Parcel Containing
 bee it more or less, lyeth on bever pond plains bounded with
 And with Rogger Smiths South, with John Rogger North
 Containing four Acres, and to Equall it to other Land on the
 lyeth In all four Acres and one Road, be it more or less, lyeth on the
 plaine bounded with the Comon East, and west with John Smiths South
 with John Beards North (note) one Road for Satisfaction is not to be
 with Rator.

Henry Botchford hath for his Second Division of meadow half the
 ten pole, be it more or less, lying in the Round Meadow, bounded with

Nathaniell Baldwin hath for his halfe Division of Land six Acres and a

 Land one Acre three Roods and thirty pole, in all eight Acres a halfe and thirty
 pole be it more or less, lying on the New Meadow plaine bounded with a high
 way East, with the Comon North, and west, with Thomas Vffords South (note)
 Acre three Roods and thirty pole for Satisfaction is not to be Charged with Rator.
