Throat hath ten acres of land giuen to him by the town
The Indian side midle hill in the Indian side, it is freely
giuen to him, not hauing any reference to any diuision
also the town hath directed their minds by a vote
that they are willing he shall have it rate free till he
shall improve it

It is ordered that a halfe diuision of Land shall be
out to the town
